Lesson Title: The story of the Elephant

Warm up Activity:

There are a number of suggestions that **are** supposed to be a good prologue:

The teacher can start the lesson by reciting surat al-Feel; followed by the story. She can use books, pictures, power point presentation...

No more than 7 minutes

After the story the teacher can listen to the students' participation and questions, later she can give them a worksheet for evaluation. Gifts can be given to the winners.

Another suggestion is to give a group of students few books related to the story and ask them to prepare it at home. The teacher can divide the events of the story and assigns one part to every student who will play the role of the teacher.

4. conclude that Allah protected the Ka`bah and explain the significance of the story	Note: here the teacher can talk about the power of Allah to strengthen their belief in Allah and in His Power and Protection. Abraham planned to attack the Ka`bah and sent a huge army of men and elephants to Makkah. Allah(عزوجل) protected the Ka`bah as a place for his worship alone and He subdued the plots of those who wished to destroy tawheed on earth. This story shows that Allah(عزوجل) alone was able to protect the Ka`bah and destroy those who wanted to destroy it.	5 min.	story power point presentation Discussion	Direct Question
