4. recall the meaning of shahadah:	<p>praying inside. Then show them various pictures and videos of the Ka`bah and al-Masjid al-Haraam.</p> <p>The teacher talks to the students about the Ka`bah It is the place where we worship Allah. The spot where the Ka`bah is built, was chosen by Allah since the time of prophet Ibrahim peace be upon him).</p> <p>She can take them on a trip to the mosque of the city (if possible) where they can perform Salah.</p> <p>She can remind them of the early lessons related to the shahadah. (there is no god worthy of worship except Allah). Muslims worship only Allah our Creator, we do respect the Ka`bah and we do as the messenger of Allah, صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ, told us to do when we are in Baytullah al-Haraam.</p> <p>She can ask them about the meaning of the 1<sup>st</sup> part of the shahadah. (There is no god worthy of worship except Allah).</p> <p>Ask them questions that lead them to the fact that we do not worship the Ka`bah or anything else.</p> <p>We worship only Allah Our Creator.</p>	10 min.	board	Questions
