Lesson Title: *Soorah at-Takweer*: The Folding Up **Date:**
(Part 2)

Warm up Activity:

There are some suggestions that are supposed to be a good prologue:

The teacher will remind the students of the previous ayat from the Soorah: 6 events take place in this life (ayah 1-6) and 6 events in the Hereafter (ayah 7-14).

No more than 2 minutes

Students will be encouraged to recite the previous ayat together. Or, the teacher may choose a student to recite the ayat, and students will repeat after him/her.

By the end of the lesson the student should be able to				
1. give the meaning of the ayat (15-18).	The teacher may explain to students that in these ayat Allah swears by the stars which appear and disappear, the night as it comes slowly, the morning that takes a breath after night chokes the day. Allah has the power of all these events and many more, but humans don't have the powers over anything.	5 min.	Discussion	Continuous Discussion
2. recite the previous ayat from memory.	With a lot of motivation, the teacher will encourage the students to continue memorization of the mentioned ayat. The teacher may use a video recording of a recitation of the mentioned ayat. Also, he/she may use body gestures while reciting to increase the students' memorization ability.	5 min.	Video recording/ Body gestures/ Drill	The teacher will randomly choose one student to start reciting the soorah from the beginning. He/she will stop him at any time and choose another one to continue, and so forth till the ayat are finished.

3. defend the idea that the Qur'aan has been altered.	<p>The teacher may draw three boxes above one another, on the board. In the upper one, he/she writes "Allah". In the middle one, he/she writes "Angel Jibreel". In the lowest one, he/she writes "Prophet Muhammad".</p> <p>The teacher will inform students that there are 2 stages between humans and Allah.</p> <p>First Allah entrusted the Angel Jibreel with the Qur'aan. Jibreel , who is very powerful, he has been suited next to Allah's Throne, he has a high status, Other Angels obey him, and he is trustworthy. Imagine from the worldly perspective – When a high ranked person comes with an expensive package – he has guards surrounding him. This is a highly classified message, and the one who is delivering it has a high and noble rank, and with him are guards who obey his commands happily. Second, Jibreel delivered the message to Prophet Muhammad, who was called the honest and trustworthy by the people of Quraysh and he is not asking for money for doing this job.</p>	10 min. 5. explain the meaning of the last four ayat	<p>The teacher will draw a big red heart on the board, inside it, he/she will write the ayah "So, where are you going?"</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>فأين تذهبون</p> </div> <p>The teacher will explain that this is the heart of the Soorah by saying, "Then after knowing all this information – where are you heading? The world of corrupt knowledge. Or the authentic knowledge which has been preserved in every way. Which one will you choose? So oh disbelievers of</p>	5 min.		questions

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	<p>Quraysh, this message doesn't need you, and if you disbelieve – others can also be chosen in preference to you. (aalameen; nations of; jinn, angels, men). So what intents are you going to make except by the will of Allah? You can't, so do your bit and ask Him to help you in that guidance. He will help you – the One who even has the power to change the way the universe runs”</p>
