**Lesson Title: The Benefits of Zakah**

**Warm up Activity:**

The teacher asks the upper grade students to help to perform a play in the morning assembly.

No more than 7 minutes

The play talks about a rich family and a poor family. The father of the rich family came home one day with lots of money which he earned. They remove the amount they need for the housing, food, schooling, clothing, toys, trips, gifts,.... They found that they still have some money left. At that point the grandfather interfere and teaches the family and the audience the lesson about the Zakah and how they should share their happiness with their neighbors and give them some money.
