1. recall that obeying Allah is `Ibadah/ worship and Allah will reward us if we do.	<p>The teacher can use many questions to lead the students to realize and discover the objective.</p> <p><u>For example:</u></p> <p>The teacher can write on the board the names of the Qur'an teacher, Arabic teacher, English teacher, French teacher,....</p> <p>She asks the students: If you do the Arabic homework, who will reward you the Arabic teacher or the English teacher? They will say the Arabic teacher. If you do the Qur'an homework who will reward you?
