

**DAILY LESSON PLAN**  
**G1-Unit 6 lesson 3**

**Lesson Title: Reading the Qur'aan**

**Warm up Activity:**

We can start the lesson with the following activity: The teacher enters the class with a big box of candy (or stickers if candy is not allowed) and tells the students that she has gifts for the one who did hasanat this morning.

2 candies for every hasanah. Then she asks who did 100 hasanah this morning? The students will say no one did. The teacher asks who did 50 hasanat today. No one. 40, 30, 20? No one. The teacher puts the box under the table and takes out a huge enlarged copy of surat al-Fatiha. She sticks it on the board, divide the class into groups based on their number, and ask each group to count the number of letters in surat al-Fatiha. She goes around between the students and monitors the work, and put their results on the board.
